



German Language School Seattle Registration 2025-2026

Registration

Registration for the school year 2025-2026 will start on April 1. We encourage early registration through May 17 by offering a \$120 discount per student. After that, regular registration continues through September 5. This will allow us to prepare class assignments in advance of the first day of school on September 13.

The school year 2025-2026 includes 32 classes and the dates are listed in the [GLS Calendar 2025-2026](#). Classes will be held in person on Saturdays from 9:30am to 12:00pm at the Villa Academy.

We offer quick and easy online registration in four simple steps through our website. New families will complete all four steps. Returning families wishing to update their information will complete all four steps. Returning families wanting to register only will jump directly to Step 4.

Step 1 – Member Area: Please visit the [“Register”](#) portion of the website to create a member account. You may sign up using your email, Facebook, or Google credentials. The person setting up the account is the first parent/guardian or adult student (“member”).

Step 2 - My Account: Once you have created an account, you will log in with your email, Facebook, or Google credentials. You will land on the “My Account” menu item where you provide (or update) the contact information for the first parent/guardian or adult student.

Step 3 - Student Information: Next, the first parent/guardian or adult student selects “Student Information” from the menu and fills in the required fields in this section. This includes information about the student(s), the second parent/guardian (not required for adult student), and the emergency contact.

Step 4 – Registration: Once these three steps are completed, the first parent/guardian or adult student selects “Registration 2025-2026” from the menu and fills in the required fields in this section. The registration can only be completed after all previous steps have been followed. Upon checkout, you will receive a booking confirmation by email.

Classes

Classes are offered for different skill levels. Enrollment will be determined based on age and existing German knowledge. Our school offers the following classes:

Preschool/Kindergarten - Vorschule

This class for our youngest students (ages 4-6) teaches German in a playful way. Students explore topics through song, story, play, movement, as well as arts and crafts. The class emphasizes the spoken language, but students also learn to read and write letters and simple words at their level. They acquire knowledge about cultural traditions in German-speaking countries through specific events and activities.

Elementary School – Grundstufe

This class for students in elementary school (ages 6-9) brings a playful approach to the academic content of German language learning. Activities include games, songs, stories, and seasonal arts and crafts. Students strengthen their communication, reading, and writing skills at their level. They acquire knowledge about cultural traditions in German-speaking countries through specific events and activities. In some cases, advanced students in this group may take the *Internationale Vergleichsarbeit (A1)*.

Beginner Youth – Anfänger Jugendliche

This class is intended for middle and high school students with beginner knowledge of German. The spoken language plays a predominant role in this class, but students also expand their reading and writing skills. They learn about cultural traditions in German-speaking countries through specific events and activities.

Middle School – Mittelstufe

This class is intended for students (ages 9-12) in elementary and middle school with intermediate to advanced knowledge of German. Both the spoken and written language receive attention in this class, and students expand their reading and writing skills. They learn about cultural traditions in German-speaking countries through specific events and activities. Students may take the *National German Exam (Level 1)* and the *Internationale Vergleichsarbeit (A1 and A2)*.

High School I - Oberstufe I

This class is geared towards students in middle and high school (ages 11-14) with intermediate to advanced knowledge of German. Students learn to maintain a fluent conversation in German about everyday topics, and they enhance their reading and writing skills through more complex texts. Students also explore contemporary culture in German-speaking countries through songs, movies, and other media. Students may take the *National German Exam (Level 2 and 3)*, the

Internationale Vergleichsarbeit (A2), and the *Deutsche Sprachdiplom (DSD I)*.

High School II - Oberstufe II

This class is geared towards students (ages 12 and up) in middle and high school with advanced to fluent knowledge of German. Students explore the German language through different and complex types of texts as well as audio and video materials. All four language skills (listening, speaking, reading, and writing) are strengthened, and emphasis is placed on reproductive oral and written language skills in preparation for exams. Students explore contemporary culture in German-speaking countries through songs, movies, and other media. Students may take the *National German Exam* (Level 3 and 4), the *Deutsche Sprachdiplom (DSD I and DSD II)*, and the Advanced Placement (AP) German Exam.

Intermediate Adult – Fortgeschrittene Erwachsene

This adult class is designed for students who have taken German in the past and who can communicate at a basic level. Students acquire beginner to intermediate communication, reading, and writing skills. They also learn about the culture, history, and geography in German-speaking countries.

Trial Class – Schnupperstunde

A student interested in enrolling at the GLS may sign up for a free trial session in the desired class. This is an opportunity to meet the teacher, learn about the curriculum, and experience the school's culture. A trial session will help the student determine if the class is the right fit for the student's language skills and goals.

Tuition Structure

We strongly encourage early registration for next school year. This will help us plan our class offering and staffing need. As an incentive, we provide a \$120 discount for early registration by May 17.

Our tuition structure reflects a moderate increase to offset higher costs in rent, accounting, technology, and class materials. Tuition will be the same amount for children and adults. The discount for families with two, three, or more children will remain in effect.

The tuition includes a student workbook.

Tuition must be paid either 50% or in full at registration, and it must be paid on time. A late fee of \$25 applies to all payments received late.*
